Dr. Pravakar Mallick, the coordinator, read out the proceedings of the last session for notification by the esteemed members. All the members unanimously accepted the proceedings. Discussion on the prescribed agenda kicked off after the chairperson invited suggestions from the members about the modalities of organising the 40<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day ceremony in the college. After a lot of interaction among the members the following resolutions were unanimously adopted.

1. On the occasion of the Foundation Day of the college three best achievers in the last university examination 2018 shall be felicitated with cash awards. The College shall invite some eminent educationist/ social activists to grace the occasion and address the students. Prospective alumni shall be invited to share their success stories and inspire the students.
2. In view of the problems arising out of the conducting in door meeting, the college shall apply to the UGC/MHRD for sanction of funds for construction of an auditorium with a minimum seating capacity of 500 seats.
3. The principal shall take expeditious steps for recruitment of guest faculties / teachers on contractual basis to fill up the vacancies in the different teaching departments and ensure engagement of classes without any Frequency of parent-teacher meetings shall be accelerated with a view to bridging the gap between the teachers and guardians.
4. Mentor-mentee practices shall be sincerely followed to revive the lost Guru-Sishya tradition.

1. The IQAC, through the N.S.S units and some other students volunteers shall periodically arrange plantation programmes in the neighbouring villages and create community awareness on the indispensability of biodiversity.
2. IQAC shall organize health check up camps at reasonable intervals to ensure proper health and hygiene of the campus.
3. Life skills-training programmes like swimming, driving light vehicles and health management shall be conducted to build among the girls the capacity to make decisions and take actions that positively impact their lives and the lives of those around them.
4. The principal shall take the assistance of external agencies to make the programmes effective and meaningful.
5. IQAC shall prepare and submit the AQARs for 2016-17 and 2017-18 academic sessions for submission to NAAC.
6. Principal was requested to take necessary steps for the increase of seats in +3 Commerce from 32 to 64 from the session 2019-20.
7. It was also resolved to open Geology subject in +3 Science from the session 2019-20 with 64 seats and increase of seats from 160 to 224 in +3 Science.
8. Decision was taken to increase seats in Economics from 08 to 16 and in Home Science from 16 to 32.

At the end of the meeting Prof. Bhakta Ranjan Nayak, thanked all the members for their participation in the meaningful interaction.
