Any other Remarks: +3 Final degree students and staff members of Zoology department of Tulasi Womens college, Kendrapara visited Zoological park of Nandankanan located in Bhubaneswar on 20th December 2019 to study the Morphological characters and Behaviour of different animals. The State Zoological park is a 437 hector (1080 acre) Zoo located near the capital city Bhubaneswar in close proximity with the Chandaka forest and Kanjia lake (134 acre). It was the first Zoo in India to join World Association of Zoo and Aquarium (WAZA) in 2009. It is home to about 1660 individual animals including 67 species of mammals, 81 species of birds and 19 species of reptiles. The zoo enjoys a good reputation internationally for successfully breeding *Black panthera*, Gharials and white tigers in captivity. Twenty nine students visited the Nandankanan Zoological Park and prepared their Project Reports for Partial fulfillment of 6th semester University examination of Zoology. They prepared reports on Lion, Tiger, Hyena, Leopard, Deer Elephant, Gorilla, Hippopotamus, Peacock, Vulture, Indian spotted Eagle, Turaco Violet Bird, Crocodile, Turtle and Tortoise, Burmese Python, King Cobra, Russell Viper and Common Krait. Students also visited the safari inside the zoo arena which is home to the popular Asiatic lion and gorgeous white tiger. Students also did boating in the Kanjia lake and light refreshment & lunch was arranged there. Students enjoyed the tour while gaining practical knowledge and insights about the fauna and biodiversity of the park and thus tour was successfully organized.
